

Calendar of Dates for Recognition, Dialogue and Celebration for Trans, Gender Diverse and Intersectional Communities

Month	Date	Name	About
February	All month	LGBT History Month	LGBT History Month is a month-long annual observance of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender history, and the history of the LGBT rights and related civil rights movements. The month is dedicated to celebrating role models, building community, and making a civil rights statement about the national and international contribution of LGBTQI+ people.
March	8 th	International Women's Day	International Women's Day is an event occurring on March 8 th every year. The day is dedicated to commemorating the women's rights movements, and celebrates the social, economic, cultural and political achievement of women.
March	31 st	International Trans Day of Visibility	International Trans Day of Visibility (TDOV) is an event occurring on March 31 st each year. The day is dedicated to celebrating trans people and raising awareness of discrimination faced by trans people worldwide.
June	All month	LGBT Pride Month	LGBT Pride events occur annually in cities across the UK, usually in the months of June, July and August. Pride celebrates and makes visible LGBTQI+ communities, through public marches, parades and events.
September	I O th	World Suicide Prevention Day	World Suicide Prevention Day is an annual event occurring on September 10 th each year. The day is dedicated to raising awareness about suicide through dialogue and events.
September	23 rd	Bi Visibility Day	Bi Visibility Day is an annual event occurring on September 23 rd each year. The day is dedicated to celebrate and make visible bisexuality, and to highlight discrimination faced by bisexual people.
October	All month	Black History Month (UK)	Black History Month, also known as African-American History Month in North America, is a month-long annual observance for remembrance and celebration of important people and events in the ongoing history of the African diaspora.
October	th	National Coming Out Day	National Coming Out Day is an event occurring on October 11 th each year. The day is dedicated to making LGBTQI+ lives visible, to challenge cultures of silence and shame, and to celebrate identities and communities.
October	Varies	Hate Crime Awareness Week	Hate Crime Awareness Week is a week-long event occurring in early/mid-October each year. The week is dedicated to raising awareness and encouraging reporting of hate crime in the UK, and remembering victims.
November	I st – 19 th	Trans Awareness Week	Trans Awareness Week occurs annually in the first two weeks of November, leading up to TDOR (see below). The purpose of the weeks is to raise awareness about trans and gender diverse people, through education, events, and celebration.
November	20 th	International Trans Day of Remembrance	International Trans Day of Remembrance (TDOR) is an event occurring on November 20 th each year. The day is dedicated to remembering trans people who have lost their lives to violence or suicide, and to raising awareness of discrimination faced by trans people worldwide.
November - December	22 nd – 22 nd	Disability History Month	Disability History Month is a month-long observance occurring between November 22 nd and December 22 nd each year. The month is dedicated to creating a platform to explore disability history and human rights.
December	st	World AIDs Day	World AIDs Day is an annual event occurring on December 1 st . The day is dedicated to raising awareness of HIV and AIDs, and to mourning those who have died of the disease.
